## News Notes from Mort

**Bluff, New Zealand.** New Zealand has the highest rate of teen suicide and pregnancy among developing nations according to a report issued by the United Nations. The report came during the first week of a bicycle tour that seeks to address "at risk" behavior among young people in the country. Since New Zealand is well-known for its world-quality cyclists, it is no wonder that eight cyclists from Adventist churches are taking part in a six-day 2,229-kilometer ride. It began in Bluff in Southern New Zealand and will visit 23 towns and end in Cape Reigna. It is called the Circle of Courage tour aimed to help build resilience and self esteem in young people.

**Cape Town, South Africa.** Some 500 participants, including government officials, ambassadors, church leaders, lay leaders and religious freedom experts, gathered here for the Sixth World Congress of the International Religious Liberty Association (IRLA).

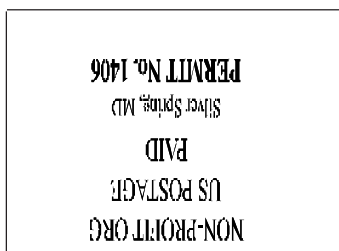
